Revision 2 of Volume 2 Conditions of Contract is issued with this addenda and has amended the Contract Defect Liability Period requirement. The Defect Liability Period requirement has been changed as detailed below:

### Annexure A Item 27 Defects Liability Period:

Changed to 12 months.

### **Site Visit Details**

The site visit will be split into two parts, Warri Gate Road and Innamincka Road, with a significant distance between the two roads, travelling on other roads. Upon completion of the in-room portion of the pre-tender meeting the inspection of the two roads will be undertaken. The proposed route will not see a return to Noccundra.

Warri Gate Road will be inspected first. Stops are intended at locations of interest to enable Tenderers to inspect worksites, a quarry pit, camp sites and turn around sites. Tenderers must note that the inspection undertaken will not cover the entire length of Warri Gate Road.

Following inspection of Warri Gate Road a cross country route to Innamincka Road will be taken. It is proposed to have lunch in Innamincka. Some food and drinks will be supplied by the Innamincka Hotel.

Innamincka Road will be inspected via the return journey to Thargomindah. Stops will be made at locations of interest to enable Tenderers to inspect worksites, quarry pits, camp sites and turn around sites.

The proposed route maps are provided as attachments to this addenda. It must be noted that the proposed travel route is subject to appropriate weather conditions and may be altered due to closed roads and/or adverse weather.

It must be noted that due to the significant distances required to complete the proposed inspections, that stops will not be made at all sites identified in the contract works. Tenderers are welcome to take extra time before or after the Thursday pre-tender meeting and site inspection to further acquaint themselves with the sites and the Bulloo Shire.

### **Outback Safety**

The area the site visit will cover is extremely remote with no mobile phone coverage. A suitable two-way radio fitted to the vehicle is highly recommended and some commentary may be provided via UHF during the trip. Satellite phones are also highly recommended and can be rented if not owned. There is no mobile phone coverage outside of Thargomindah.

Personnel joining the site visit will require a vehicle suitable for travelling long distances on unsealed roads, some of which may be in poor condition. All vehicles must be in good working order and have recovery equipment to be able to self-rescue if required. There is fuel in Thargomindah, Noccundra and Innamincka only. It is strongly recommended that all vehicles leave Thargomindah or other accommodation location with a full tank of fuel.

The expected site visit duration will be at least 9 hours from the departure from Noccundra to the return to Thargomindah. Personnel will require suitable covered footwear, clothing, hat and a high visibility vest. All personnel will need to be self-sufficient with food and water. Lunch will be provided in Innamincka.

People wishing to leave the site inspection at any time must notify Shepherd personnel to ensure everyone can be accounted for. People who leave the site inspection must also notify Shepherd personnel on their arrival at their destination to ensure their safety.




