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<b>Terms and Conditions</b>
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**PERMITS**

- Any animal/s (stock) that is kept in town for more than two (2) weeks must have a permit per animal.
- The keeping of more than three horses, calves / cattle, sheep, and/or goats on any land is absolutely prohibited.
- The keeping of up to three horses, calves / cattle, sheep, and/or goats is absolutely prohibited on land having an area less than 1500m<sup>2</sup>. For the purposes of this policy, land means either a single allotment or several adjoining vacant allotments of an aggregate of not less than 1500m<sup>2</sup>.
- Where a horse, cow, sheep, or goat is to be kept on more than one (1) allotment in order to obtain the benefit of this policy, the keeper of the horse, cow, sheep or goat must obtain written permission from the owner or owners of the allotment or allotments upon which the horse, cow, sheep or goat is to be kept, prior to allowing the horse, cow, sheep or goat to be kept on those allotments.

**LOCAL LAW NO.6 (KEEPING AND CONTROL OF ANIMALS)**

A copy of Local Law No.6 (Keeping and Control of Animals) is attached with relevant sections highlighted for your information.

**Horses Only** (as adopted at the Ordinary Meeting of Council held 10<sup>th</sup> April 1996)

This Resolution is in conjunction with Local Law No.6 section 24 Duty to Provide Proper Enclosure.

- If the yard is not securely fenced then there must be a stall built, and therefore that must have a roof and no walls in which to contain the animals.
- A maximum of four (4) horse stalls per allotment will be allowed at a rate of one (1) stall per 500 m<sup>2</sup>
- The maximum size for a shelter or stall is 4.5 m<sup>2</sup>, with a maximum height of 4.88 metres, and a minimum size shelter or stall will be 3.6 m<sup>2</sup>, with a minimum height of 3 metres.
